1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 613, Page 1, in the Title, Line 4, by
2 deleting the word "firearms" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "public safety"; and
3

4 Further amend said bill, Page 35, Section 590.207, Line 7, by inserting after all of said section and
5 line the following:

7 "590.705. 1. All uniformed law enforcement officers in this state shall wear a video camera
8 affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty. The video camera shall record the
9 interaction between a law enforcement officer and a member of the public. The recording shall
10 include both audio and video.

11 2. All law enforcement agencies shall preserve any recordings made by a video camera
12 under this section for a minimum of thirty days and shall develop any policies and procedures
13 necessary to execute the provisions of this section.

14 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to detectives or other law enforcement
15 officers while they are working in an undercover capacity, or to any law enforcement officer in any
16 situation where the wearing of such a video camera would endanger the safety of the officer or the
17 public."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20 accordingly.
