1 AMEND House Bill No. 1157, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2 and 3,  
2 by deleting the words "the privacy of student data" and inserting  
3 in lieu thereof the following: "education"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 161.108, Line 58,  
6 by inserting after all of said line the following:

7 "161.960. 1. There is hereby established in the department  
8 of elementary and secondary education a "Council for Community  
9 Education".

10 2. The council shall have a membership of eleven persons,  
11 appointed by the governor. Membership may include, but not be  
12 limited to, representatives of the following groups:

- 13 (1) Civic organizations;
- 14 (2) Community-based organizations;
- 15 (3) Community education organizations;
- 16 (4) Local government;
- 17 (5) Local school district administrators;
- 18 (6) Parent organizations;
- 19 (7) Post-secondary education;
- 20 (8) School boards; and
- 21 (9) Teachers.

22 3. The commissioner of education or the commissioner's  
23 designee shall convene the first meeting of the council for the  
24 purpose of establishing the bylaws of the council and electing  
25 officers to include a chairperson, vice chairperson, and  
26 secretary. The council shall not meet more than four times  
27 annually. Members may be reimbursed for expenses but shall not  
28 receive a per diem allowance.

29 4. The council shall:

1 (1) Conduct feasibility studies on the establishment of  
2 community education programs within the state;

3 (2) Advise the commissioner of education and the department  
4 of education on issues relating to the establishment of community  
5 education programs;

6 (3) Make recommendations for a state plan for community  
7 education which sets forth the goals and objectives of a  
8 community schools program and establishes a system of priorities  
9 for targeting available resources on the areas with the greatest  
10 need within a school district; and

11 (4) Make recommendations for the funding of local community  
12 education programs.

13 5. For purposes of this section, "community school", means  
14 a school that makes its facilities available for citizen use,  
15 coordinates activities of local citizens in identifying program  
16 needs and establishing priorities, identifies and utilizes  
17 available program resources, and assists in the initiation of  
18 programs to improve the cultural, social, recreational, and  
19 educational opportunities available in a community. "Community  
20 education program", means a program in which a public building,  
21 including a public elementary or secondary school, is used as a  
22 community center operated by a school board in cooperation with  
23 other groups in the community, community organizations, and local  
24 governmental agencies to provide educational, recreational,  
25 cultural, health care, and other related community services in  
26 accordance with the needs, interests, and concerns of the  
27 community."; and

29 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional  
30 references accordingly.
