1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 493,
2 485, 495, 516, 534, 545, 595, 616, & 624, Page 43, Section 167.825, Line 1, by inserting "1."
3 immediately after "167.825." ; and
4

5 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Lines 5 and 6, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in
6 lieu thereof the following:

7 "2. A student who has transferred under this section shall be permitted to complete middle
8 school, junior high school, or high school, whichever occurs first, except that a student who attends
9 any school serving students through high school graduation but starting at grades lower than ninth
10 grade shall be permitted to complete high school in the school to which he or she has transferred as
11 long as the student previously attended a school in the sending district for at least one semester
12 before initially transferring unless the student was an entering kindergarten or first grade student
13 and"; and
14

15 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 10, by adding after all of said line the following:

16 "3. Regardless of the accreditation status of the sending district, any student who transferred
17 out of the district in school year 2013-14 but did not attend a public school in the unaccredited
18 district shall no longer be eligible to transfer under this section in school year 2014-15." ; and

20 Further amend said bill, Page 45, Section 167.826, Line 55, by inserting immediately after the word
21 "subsection" the following:

22 "or one hundred percent of the receiving district's tuition, whichever is less," ; and

24 Further amend said bill and section, Page 46, Line 97, by deleting all of said line and inserting in
25 lieu thereof the following:

26 "complete middle school, junior high school, or high school, whichever occurs first, except
27 that a student who attends any school serving students through high school graduation but starting at
28 grades lower than ninth grade shall be permitted to complete high school in the school to which he or
29 she has transferred as long as the student previously attended a school in the sending district for at
30 least one semester before initially transferring unless the student was an entering kindergarten or first
31 grade student who applied by April of the year preceding first entry."; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
34 accordingly.
