6	plates for any vehicle she owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a
7	commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight.
8	2. Any such woman shall apply for the special personalized license plates on a form provided by the
9 10	director of revenue and furnish such proof of military service as the director may require.
10	<u>3. Upon presentation of such proof of military service, payment of a fee of fifteen dollars in addition</u> to the regular registration fees, and presentation of any documents which may be required by law, the director
12	of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner special personalized license plates which shall bear the words
13	"WOMAN VETERAN" at the bottom of the plates in a manner prescribed by the director of revenue. Such
14	license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be
15	clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130.
16	4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the
