1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 696, Page 2, Section 301.474, Line 39, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "302.137. 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury for use by the department of public
5 safety a fund to be known as the "Motorcycle Safety Trust Fund". All judgments collected pursuant
6 to this section, registration surcharges collected under subsection 4 of this section, appropriations of
7 the general assembly, federal grants, private donations and any other moneys designated for the
8 motorcycle safety education program established pursuant to sections 302.133 to 302.138 shall be
9 deposited in the fund. Moneys deposited in the fund shall, upon appropriation by the general
10 assembly to the department of public safety, be received and expended by the department of public
11 safety for the purpose of funding the motorcycle safety education program established under sections
12 302.133 to 302.138. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any
13 unexpended balance in the motorcycle safety trust fund at the end of any biennium shall not be
14 transferred to the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the
15 same manner as surplus state funds are invested under section 30.260. Any interest and moneys
16 earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

17 2. In all criminal cases, including violations of any county ordinance or any violation of
18 criminal or traffic laws of this state, including an infraction, there shall be assessed as costs a
19 surcharge in the amount of one dollar. No such surcharge shall be collected in any proceeding
20 involving a violation of an ordinance or state law when the proceeding or defendant has been
21 dismissed by the court or when costs are to be paid by the state, county or municipality.

22 3. Such surcharge shall be collected and distributed by the clerk of the court as provided in
23 sections 488.010 to 488.020. The surcharge collected pursuant to this section shall be paid to the
24 state treasury to the credit of the motorcycle safety trust fund established in this section.

25 4. Beginning January 1, 2015, a registration surcharge in the amount of five dollars shall be
26 added to each motorcycle registration fee charged by the department of revenue under the authority
27 prescribed in this chapter for all new motorcycle registrations and all motorcycle registration
28 renewals. Surcharges collected under this subsection shall be paid to the state treasury to the credit
29 of the motorcycle safety trust fund established in this section."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
32 accordingly.
