1 AMEND House Bill No. 1191, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by  
 2 inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "67.1367. 1. The governing body of any county of the third  
 4 classification without a township form of government and with  
 5 more than eighteen thousand but fewer than twenty thousand  
 6 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with  
 7 more than eight thousand but fewer than nine thousand inhabitants  
 8 as the county seat may impose a tax on the charges for all  
 9 sleeping rooms paid by the transient guests of hotels or motels  
 10 situated in the county or a portion thereof, which shall be no  
 11 more than six percent per occupied room per night, except that  
 12 such tax shall not become effective unless the governing body of  
 13 the county submits to the voters of the county at a state general  
 14 or primary election, a proposal to authorize the governing body  
 15 of the county to impose a tax pursuant to this section. The tax  
 16 authorized by this section shall be in addition to the charge for  
 17 the sleeping room and shall be in addition to any and all taxes  
 18 imposed by law and the proceeds of such tax shall be used by the  
 19 county solely for the promotion of tourism. Such tax shall be  
 20 stated separately from all other charges and taxes.

 22 section shall be in substantially the following form:
