1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 672,
2 Page 4, Section 49.266, Line 22, by inserting immediately after said line the following:
3 "49.272. The county commission of any county of the first classification without a charter
4 form of government and with more than one hundred thirty-five thousand four hundred but less than
5 one hundred thirty-five thousand five hundred inhabitants, [and in] any county of the first
6 classification without a charter form of government having a population of at least eighty-two
7 thousand inhabitants, but less than eighty-two thousand one hundred inhabitants, any county of the
8 first classification with more than one hundred four thousand six hundred but fewer than one
9 hundred four thousand seven hundred inhabitants, any county of the first classification with more
10 than one hundred ninety-eight thousand but fewer than one hundred ninety-nine thousand two
11 hundred inhabitants, [and] any county of the first classification with more than two hundred forty
12 thousand three hundred but less than two hundred forty thousand four hundred inhabitants, and any
13 county of the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer than ninety-two
14 thousand inhabitants and with a home rule city with more than seventy-six thousand but fewer than
15 ninety-one thousand inhabitants as the county seat, which has an appointed county counselor and
16 which adopts or has adopted rules, regulations or ordinances under authority of a statute which
17 prescribes or authorizes a violation of such rules, regulations or ordinances to be a misdemeanor
18 punishable as provided by law, may by rule, regulation or ordinance impose a civil fine not to exceed
19 one thousand dollars for each violation. Any fines imposed and collected under such rules,
20 regulations or ordinances shall be payable to the county general fund to be used to pay for the cost of
21 enforcement of such rules, regulations or ordinances."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
