1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 745, Page 1, in the Title, Line 4, by deleting the
2 words "operations of the office of sherriff" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "law
3 enforcement"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 28, Section 571.111, Line 117, by inserting immediately after all of
6 said lines the following:

8 "575.153. 1. A person commits the crime of disarming a peace officer, as defined in section
9 [590.100] 590.010, or a correctional officer if such person intentionally:

10 (1) Removes a firearm [or other], deadly weapon, or less-lethal weapon, to include blunt
11 impact, chemical or conducted energy devices, used in the performance of his or her official duties
12 from the person of a peace officer or correctional officer while such officer is acting within the scope
13 of his or her official duties; or

14 (2) Deprives a peace officer or correctional officer of such officer's use of a firearm [or],
15 deadly weapon, or any other equipment described in subdivision (1) of this subsection while the
16 officer is acting within the scope of his or her official duties.

17 2. The provisions of this section shall not apply when:

18 (1) The defendant does not know or could not reasonably have known that the person he or
19 she disarmed was a peace officer or correctional officer; or

20 (2) The peace officer or correctional officer was engaged in an incident involving felonious
21 conduct by the peace officer or correctional officer at the time the defendant disarmed such officer.

22 3. Disarming a peace officer or correctional officer is a class C felony."; and

24 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
25 accordingly.
