1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 701, Page 1, in the Title, Lines 2 and 3, by deleting the words, "school
2 superintendents" and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "elementary and secondary education"; and
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4 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section 168.205, Line 6, by inserting after all of said line the
5 following:
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7 "Section 1. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no district shall be
8 penalized for any reason under the Missouri school improvement program if students who graduate
9 from the district complete career and technical education programs approved by the department of
10 elementary and secondary education but are not placed in occupations directly related to their
11 training within six months of graduating.

12 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall revise its scoring guide
13 under the Missouri school improvement program to provide additional points to districts that create
14 and enter into a partnership with area career centers, comprehensive high schools, industry, and
15 business to develop and implement a pathway for students to:

16 (1) Enroll in a program of career and technical education while in high school;

17 (2) Participate and complete an internship or apprenticeship during their final year of high
18 school; and

19 (3) Obtain the industry certification or credentials applicable to their program or career and
20 technical education and internship or apprenticeship.

21 3. Each school district shall be authorized to create and enter into a partnership with area
22 career centers, comprehensive high schools, industry, and business to develop and implement a
23 pathway for students to:

24 (1) Enroll in a program of career and technical education while in high school;

25 (2) Participate and complete an internship or apprenticeship during their final year of high
26 school; and

27 (3) Obtain the industry certification or credentials applicable to their program or career and
28 technical education and internship or apprenticeship.

29 4. The department of elementary and secondary education shall permit student scores, that
30 are from a nationally recognized examination that demonstrates achievement of workplace
31 employability skills, to count towards credit for college and career readiness standards on the
32 Missouri school improvement program or any subsequent school accreditation or improvement
33 program."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
