AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1303, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2-3, by deleting the words, "religious liberties of students" and inserting in lieu thereof the word, "education"; and
Further amend said bill, page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section the following: "160.2115. 1. Any school district within the state may choose to allow schools within the
district to observe a brief moment of silence at the opening of every school day in individual
classrooms, not to exceed two minutes in duration, with the participation of all the pupils assembled within the classroom. This moment shall not be conducted as a religious exercise but shall be an opportunity for silent reflection on the anticipated activities of the day.
2. School districts electing to allow schools to include a moment of silence within the school day under this section shall establish a policy on moment of silence observance which shall include, but not be limited to:
(1) A schedule for observance of the moment of silence;
(2) Expectations as to what behavior is permissible during observance of the moment of
silence; and
(3) Consequences for improper behavior during the observance of the moment of silence.";
and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
