The notice shall contain in a legible, large font all of the 9 information required for a petition under section 523.010 and the following disclaimer: 10 11 "ATTENTION: You have the right to contact legal counsel for the purpose of determining whether 12 your property is being taken for a legitimate public use and to determine appropriate compensation 13 based on the laws of Missouri. The valuation of real property for purposes of eminent domain is a 14 complex process and you may receive better valuations for your property upon the consultation and 15 use of experts such as attorneys or economists. You have the right to attend any public hearings 16 required under chapter 523 regarding the use of eminent domain. You also have the right to a civil 17 jury trial to determine the value of your property. You will receive notice regarding any filed 18 petition for condemnation of your property as required under chapter 523.". 19 20 2. If a public utility is regulated by the Missouri public service commission and the use of the power of eminent domain is in any manner contingent upon the issuance of a new certificate of 21 22 convenience and necessity by the commission, the utility shall include in the disclaimer mandated by this section an additional statement substantially similar to the following: 23 24 25 "ATTENTION: The(insert name of utility) is a public utility regulated by the Missouri Public 26 Service Commission. The commission may have power to issue or deny a certificate of convenience 27 and necessity to(insert name of utility) regarding the request for a taking of your property. You 28 have the right to contact the Missouri public service commission and appear at public hearings 29 regarding your property. You have the right to contact legal counsel to appear on your behalf before 30 the commission.". 31 32 3. The violation of this section shall result in an additional award of not more than five 33 hundred dollars to any property owner whose property is actually taken by eminent domain under 34 chapter 523. The commission, or a court of competent jurisdiction, is authorized to impose such fine upon a showing that it is more likely than not that this section was violated."; and 35 36
