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### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Governor's Office** assume there should be no added cost to their office as a result of this measure. However, if additional duties are placed on the office related to appointments in other TAFP legislation, there may be the need for additional staff resources in future years.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** state this proposal has no fiscal impact beyond existing appropriations.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation (DHT)** state the fiscal impact for this legislation is unknown. Commissioners are paid \$25 per day on the days they perform their services of the position, along with travel and miscellaneous expenses.

In response to a similar proposal (HB 472) officials from the DHT stated the fiscal impact for this legislation would include an additional \$600 annual per diem for attendance at the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission monthly meetings, plus travel and lodging expenses.

**Oversight** assumes DHT is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DHT could absorb the costs related to this proposal.
