FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS) - Children's Division (CD)** state it is unknown how recommendations coming out of this committee may influence the revision of legislation, policy or contracted services, which could create a fiscal or programmatic impact on the Division. However, this legislation and the establishment of this committee will not create a fiscal impact for the CD.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** state the requirements of the proposal will result in unknown costs that are not likely to be significant.

Oversight assumes the DESE will be able to absorb costs that are not likely to be significant within current funding levels.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Joint Committee expenses are typically covered by the Senate's Joint Contingent Expenses appropriation.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate (SEN)** state the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization beyond existing appropriations.

Officials from the **Office of Administration (OA)** state the proposal will have no fiscal impact on OA. Any costs of a legislative joint committee would be borne by the General Assembly.

Officials at the **Department of Mental Health** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective agency from this proposal.
