Officials from the Office of Prosecution Services, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department, and the Springfield Police Department did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes the proposal will not have a direct fiscal impact on the state or local political subdivisions.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


