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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume no fiscal impact to their agency and defer to local school districts regarding election costs.

This proposal was sent to all current unaccredited and provisionally accredited school districts. None of those districts responded to a request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes that if a special election was held, school districts would be responsible for the costs of that special election. There will not be a special election unless a school district becomes unaccredited; therefore, for fiscal note purposes only, Oversight will assume a fiscal impact of \$0 or (Unknown - Could exceed \$100,000).

Officials from the following school districts: Kansas City Public School District, Riverview Gardens, St. Louis Public School District, Caruthersville, Malta Bend, Spickard R-II, Calhoun, Hayti, Hickman Mills, Jennings, Normandy, Gilliam C-4, and Swedeborg R-III did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation dissolves the school board of any district upon the declaration by the State Board of Education that the district is unaccredited, and board members are relieved of their duties.

Within 45 days, a special election for new board members must be held, with the costs to be paid by the district. A member of the school board who was serving for 18 months or more is prohibited from filing as a candidate for board membership in any district for eight years following the loss of accreditation.

The bill contains an emergency clause.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
