FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Columbia** assume a loss of approximately \$90,000 per year from this proposal. The City has a red light camera program. They pay their vendor \$44 per violation to operate and maintain the equipment and the program. Their internal costs are around \$40 per violation. With the combined costs of \$84, the City would be forced to abandon their program.

Officials at the **City of Jefferson** assume that this proposal would have a negative fiscal impact on the City. However, an estimate of the negative fiscal impact is not available at this time.

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator (CTS)** assume this proposal would not result in a fiscal impact in excess of \$100,000.

Oversight assumes that any costs from CTS relating to this proposal could be absorbed within their current appropriation level.

Officials at the City of Poplar Bluff assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the Office of Prosecution Services, the Department of Revenue and the Office of the State Public Defender each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Oversight assumes that fines and court costs from traffic violations will continue to be distributed to cities, counties, schools and other local political subdivisions even though this proposal is limiting the dollar amount that can be charged on those fines.

Officials at the following cities: Ashland, Belton, Bernie, Bonne Terre, Boonville, California, Cape Girardeau, Clayton, Dardenne Prairie, Excelsior Springs, Florissant, Frontenac, Fulton, Gladstone, Grandview, Harrisonville, Independence, Joplin, Kansas City, Kearney, Knob Noster, Ladue, Lake Ozark, Lebanon, Lee Summit, Liberty, Louisiana, Maryland Heights, Maryville, Mexico, Monett, Neosho, O'Fallon, Pacific, Peculiar, Raytown, Republic, Richmond, Rolla, Sedalia, Springfield, St. Charles, St. Joseph, St. Louis, St. Robert, Sugar Creek, Sullivan, Warrensburg, Warrenton, Webb City, Weldon Spring and West Plains did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This bill limits the fine that may be imposed for a traffic violation for which no points are assessed under Section 302.302, RSMo, to no more than \$50.
