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#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** state this legislation will require procedures to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours of overtime at a cost of \$840 in FY 15.

**Oversight** assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal.
