FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office (AGO)** state this proposal authorizes the newly created committee to refer certain matters to the Attorney General's Office, and authorizes the AGO to seek appropriate relief. The AGO assumes this may result in additional referrals and additional litigation. However, the number and nature of such additional referrals and additional litigation are unknown at this time, and therefore costs are unknown. The AGO may seek additional appropriation if additional referrals or litigation result.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** assume this legislation will have a minimal fiscal impact to the Missouri Senate that can be absorbed with existing appropriations.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assumes any expenses will be covered by the Senate's Joint Contingent Expense appropriation and therefore the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.
