## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on school districts.

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education (DHE)** state that because the requirements of the bill relate only to secondary school course work, the bill has no impact on the DHE or public colleges and universities. While the bill does provide that credit earned in this manner be accepted by public colleges and universities, it does not conflict with the power of the institutional governing bodies to establish appropriate admission requirements and thus has no impact in this regard.

Officials from the **Francis Howell School District, Nixa School District, and the Fulton School District** each state there is no fiscal impact to their respective schools.

Officials from the following school districts: Blue Springs, Branson, Caruthersville, Charleston R-I, Cole R-I, Columbia, Fair Grove, Harrison R-IX, Independence, Jefferson City, Johnson County R-7, Kansas City, Kirksville, Kirbyville R-V, Lee's Summit, Malden R-I, Malta Bend, Mexico, Monroe City R-I, Parkway, Pattonville, Raymore-Peculiar R-III, Raytown, Riverview Gardens, Sedalia, Sikeston, Silex, Special School District of St. Louis County, Spickard R-II, Springfield, St Joseph, St Louis, St. Charles, Sullivan, Warren County R-III, and Waynesville did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Officials from the following colleges and universities indicated no fiscal impact resulting from this proposal: **Linn State Technical College, Missouri Western State University, University of Central Missouri, University of Missouri System, Lincoln University, Missouri Southern State University, Northwest Missouri State University, and Missouri State University.**

Officials from the following colleges and universities: Crowder, East Central Community College, Harris-Stowe, Jefferson College, Kansas City Metro Community College, Moberly Area Community College, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College, Three Rivers Community College, and Truman State University, did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.

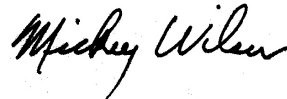
