FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS) - Children's Division (CD)** state this proposal gives the court discretion in denying custody and visitation rights of a parent if the court has found that a parent attempted to coerce the mother of the unborn child into obtaining an abortion, as well as removing the requirements of getting consent from that parent for adoption. The Division does not anticipate that his proposal will have a fiscal or programmatic impact on the CD.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator (CTS)** indicate they would not expect the proposal to have a significant fiscal impact on the courts. However, if other similar bills pass that result in additional duties to the courts, the combined impact could result in a request for additional appropriations.
