FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Columbia Police Department** and the **City of Columbia** each assume an unknown fiscal impact from this proposal. There could be increased staff time to manage possible increased requests relating to this proposal.

Officials at the **Springfield Police Department** assume an unknown fiscal impact from this proposal. This proposal could potentially have an impact on agencies doing the fingerprinting and record reviews.

Officials at the **Office of Sheriff of Jackson County** assume a minimal fiscal impact from this proposal. This proposal would only apply to a limited number of cases within their county.

Officials at the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal as they do not believe it will greatly increase their workload and they will collect the required fee to do the background check which covers their cost.

Officials at the City of Kansas City, the Cole County, the St. Louis County and the City of Jefferson each assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

Oversight assumes that if a local political subdivision is going to require the background check it will collect a fee, to cover the cost of the background check.
