FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Kansas City Board of Election Commission** assume they can not determine at this time the impact on their operations. They are not sure what kind of activity the SOS's new on-line voter registration program would generate.

Officials at the **Jackson County Board of Election Commission** assume a savings up to \$2,000 for not having to send registration cards out for bad signature received from the online registration process not matching the current signature on file.

Officials at the Lincoln County, the Platte County Board of Election Commission and the St. Louis County Board of Election Commission each assume there is no fiscal impact to their organization from this proposal.

Officials at the following board of election commissions: St. Louis City Board of Election Commission and the Clay County Board of Election Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
