#### ASSUMPTION

#### § 252.340 - Blue Catfish Length Limits:

Officials from the **Department of Conservation** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal could result in a loss of revenue from fines for the violation of blue catfish length limits to MDC.

**Oversight** assumes any loss in fine revenue to MDC would be minimal. Any loss would be absorbed by the department resulting in no direct fiscal impact.
