FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This proposal may have a direct fiscal impact on small business health care providers as it removes the geographic proximity requirement as long as the parties of the collaborative practice arrangement maintain effective electronic communications. This could allow greater access to healthcare because rural collaborators would not have to remain within a specified milage proximity. Physicians may also do electronic records review which could save administrative costs.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
