FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at **St. Louis County** assumed an unknown fiscal impact from this proposal. The cost of producing the proposed affidavit might be nominal. Their office assists an average between 4 to 6 incarcerated applicants per year with similar requests. Currently, the costs for printing information forms for the estimated 4 to 6 applicant requests are absorbed in the costs for purchasing bulk paper and bulk toner. Thus, it is difficult to determine any anticipated explicit costs at this time.

Oversight assumes counties can absorb these printing costs and therefore will show this as a no fiscal impact proposal.

Officials at the **Department of Public Safety's Missouri Veteran's Commission** and the **Office of Adjutant General (Missouri National Guard)** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Department of Corrections** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Jefferson City Police Department**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **Franklin County Recorder of Deeds** and the **Mississippi County Recorder of Deeds** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Columbia Police Department**, the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** and the **Boone County Recorder of Deeds** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.
