FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the State Public Defender (SPD)** assume for the purpose of the proposed legislation, and as a result of excessive caseloads, the SPD cannot assume existing staff will provide competent, effective representation for any new cases where indigent persons are charged with the proposed new crime of publishing a booking photograph.

While the number of new cases may be too few or uncertain to request additional funding for this specific bill, the SPD will continue to request sufficient appropriations to provide competent and effective representation in all cases where the right to counsel attaches.

Oversight assumes the SPD can absorb the additional caseload that may result from this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of the Attorney General** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Public Safety** - **Missouri Highway Patrol** assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the Columbia Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, Cole County Sheriff's Department, the Jefferson City Police Department, the Eureka Fire Protection District and the Springfield Police Department assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

Officials at the Office of Prosecution Services did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Independence Police Department, Jackson County Sheriff Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
