FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from **Northwest Missouri State University** assume this proposal could save their organization up to \$46,670 per year.

Officials from the **University of Missouri** assume this proposal would have no significant fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** stated it is unlikely this proposal would result in any savings to their organization.

Officials from the **Fulton Public Schools** responded to our request for information but did not provide an estimate of fiscal impact.

Officials from **Johnson County R-VII School District** stated it could cost between \$75-\$95 per day to hire a substitute when an employee takes a day off.

Officials from the **Metropolitan Community Colleges** assume there would be increased administrative costs to track and monitor compensatory time.

Officials from the **University of Central Missouri** assume it would cost \$25,000 to set up a tracking system for compensatory time and \$5,000 per year to operate such a system.

Officials from **St. Charles Community College** responded to our request for information but did not provide an estimate of fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of Administration**, the **Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, the **Department of Transportation**, Linn **State Technical College**, **Missouri State University**, **Missouri Western State University**, **Cole County**, **St. Louis County**, and the **St. Louis County Directors of Elections** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

ASSUMPTION (continued)

Oversight notes this proposal would <u>allow</u> an employer to offer employees a compensatory leave time program on an hour-for-hour basis, and assumes it would be an option which could be offered to employees who are not required by federal law to be paid on a time-and-a-half basis. Accordingly, Oversight assumes this proposal would have no direct fiscal impact to the state or to local governments.
