#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** state the DMH does not knowingly serve persons who are not citizens or permanent residents of the United States. On occasion, a person that is not a citizen or permanent resident may be court ordered into the care and custody of DMH for competency evaluation. DMH will notify authorities when this happens. DMH assumes no fiscal impact as a result of this legislation.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS)** state the proposal has no fiscal impact on the following divisions: the **MO HealthNet Division**, the **Division of Legal Services**, and the **Family Support Division, Income Maintenance Unit.** 

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, and the **Office of Administration - Information Technology Services Division** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
