#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume an unknown fiscal impact from this proposal. Any losses and amounts are dependent on the number and extent of tax increment financing projects that would be disallowed due to their location in flood plains and inability to meet the corresponding geographic restrictions. Those variables are unknown.

Officials at the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Economic Development's Division of Business and Community Services** and **State Tax Commission** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at **St. Louis County**, **Cole County** and the **City of Jefferson** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

**Oversight** assumes the additional restrictions placed on possible future TIF projects will not fiscally impact local political subdivisions. Therefore, Oversight will show this fiscal note as a \$0 impact to local political subdivisions.
