Officials at the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Conservation, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Higher Education, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Public Safety's Capitol Police, the Department of Public Safety's Division of Fire Safety, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Missouri Gaming Commission, the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri House of Representatives, the Missouri National Guard, the Missouri Senate, the Office of Administration, the Office of the Governor, the Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the Office of State Treasurer each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the **Missouri Veterans Commission** assume an unknown impact.
