FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** assume the fiscal impact to the Department is unknown. The Department will be required to provide data to the committee. The bill does not specify what type of requests that this will involve, but the costs will vary depending on whether a research analyst could retrieve the information or IT would have to be involved. The Department estimates that these costs will be unknown but less than \$100,000.

Officials at the **Missouri Senate** assume no fiscal impact beyond existing appropriations.

Officials at the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight assumes that the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations can absorb the duties associated with this proposal with existing resources. Should the information needed by the Joint Committee be more than current staff can handle, additional resources could be sought through the appropriation process.
