FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume this legislation would require the DOR to establish means by which a lienholder is to notify the owner of the release of lien.

The following procedures will need to be implemented for the changes in this proposal:

- Procedures will need to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours at a cost of \$840 in FY `15.
- The Department will need to draft rules to establish means by which a lienholder is to electronically notify the owner of a vehicle that the lienholder has released their lien. This will require 40 hours at a cost of \$840 in FY `15.

In summary, DOR assumes a cost of 1,680 (840 + 840) in FY 2015 to provide for the implementation of the changes in this proposal.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.
