ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, **Office of the State Public Defender**, **Office of Prosecution Services**, and **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agency.

Officials from the **Columbia Police Department** assume a possible significant impact from this proposal. Search warrants take a minimum of approximately three hours to obtain, which translates into personnel hours.

Officials from the **Springfield Police Department** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes the proposal will not have a direct fiscal impact on the state or local political subdivisions.
