#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** state to comply with this proposed legislation, the Amber Alert System will need to be integrated into the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System (MULES). The Communications and Technology Division states that to add a separate template to the system, there will be a cost of approximately \$150,000. In addition, there will be a monthly service fee of \$1,200.

Currently, funding is being proposed to enhance the system. If this funding is approved, the Patrol believes the remaining impact will be minimal and can be absorbed. However, if the proposed funding is not received, the Patrol will submit a decision item request.

**Oversight** notes that within the Perfected HCS for HB 2008 budget bill in the current session is a \$120,000 appropriation from the Services to Victims Fund for "an interface between the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System (MULES) and the Amber Alert System." Oversight will reflect in the fiscal note a \$120,000 expenditure in FY 2015, and annual maintenance costs of \$14,400, all from the Services to Victims Fund.

The Services to Victims Fund is funded by court costs assessed for violations of a criminal law of the state, including an infraction and violation of a municipal or county ordinance. The balance of the fund at the end of March, 2014 was \$2,429,879.

The proposed legislation establishes Hailey's Law that requires the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System to be integrated to interface with the Amber Alert System to expedite the reporting of child abductions.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
