#### **AN ACT**

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the Department of Agriculture, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Conservation, and the several divisions and programs thereof and for the expenses, grants, refunds, distributions, and capital improvements projects involving the repair, replacement, and maintenance of state buildings and facilities of the Department of Natural Resources and the several divisions and programs thereof to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, and to transfer money among certain funds, for the period beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015; provided that no funds from these sections shall be expended for the purpose of costs associated with the offices of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, State Treasurer, or Attorney General, and further provided that the Department of Agriculture shall employ no more than 88.25 full-time equivalent employees (FTE) from the General Revenue Fund, 34.26 FTE from federal funds, and 298.74 FTE from all other funds, and further provided that the Department of Natural Resources shall employ no more than 134.84 full-time equivalent employees (FTE) from the General Revenue Fund, 388.35 FTE from federal funds, and 1,164.88 FTE from all other funds, and further provided that the Department of Conservation shall employ no full-time equivalent employees (FTE) from the General Revenue Fund or Federal Funds, and no more than 1,794.68 FTE from the Conservation Commission Fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in 2 Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each
