AN ACT

To appropriate money for purposes for the several departments and offices of state government; for planning and capital improvements including but not limited to major additions and renovations, new structures, and land improvements or acquisitions, from the funds herein designated for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, for the agency, program, and purpose stated, chargeable to the fund designated for the period beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

Section 21.005. To the Office of Administration

- 2 For the purchase of voting machines for county clerk operations
- 3 From Surplus Revenue Fund. \$7,500,000

Section 21.010. To the Office of Administration

- 2 For expenses related to hosting a major political convention in any home
- 3 rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and
- 4 located in more than one county, provided that no funds shall be
- 5 expended unless and until a home rule city with more than four
- 6 hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county
- 7 is selected to host a major political convention
- 8 From General Revenue Fund. \$4,000,000

Section 21.015. To the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education

- 2 For construction of a recreation area at the Verelle Peniston State School
- 3 for the Severely Disabled
- 4 From General Revenue Fund. \$25,000

Section 21.020. To the University of Missouri

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of a Free Enterprise
 3 Center on the Kansas City campus, local matching funds must be
 4 provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From General Revenue Fund. \$7,400,000

Section 21.025. To the University of Missouri

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of the College of
 3 Business Administration Building on the St. Louis campus, local
 4 matching funds must be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate
 5 in order to be eligible for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480,
 6 RSMo
 7 From General Revenue Fund. \$10,000,000

Section 21.030. To the University of Missouri

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction at Lafferre Hall on the
 3 Columbia campus, local matching funds must be provided on a
 4 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From General Revenue Fund. \$6,125,000

Section 21.035. To the University of Missouri

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an experimental
 3 mine building on the Rolla campus, local matching funds must be
 4 provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From General Revenue Fund. \$1,200,000

Section 21.040. To the University of Missouri

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an applied learning
 3 center on the Columbia campus, local matching funds must be
 4 provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$11,147,000

2 Section 21.045. To the University of Missouri
 3 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of fine and performing
 4 arts facilities on the Columbia campus, local matching funds must
 5 be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 6 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 7 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$2,766,000

Section 21.050. To the University of Missouri
 2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of a teaching winery on
 3 the Columbia campus, local matching funds must be provided on
 4 a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$1,500,000

Section 21.055. To Harris-Stowe State University
 2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of the Vashon Center,
 3 local matching funds must be provided on a 50/50 state/local
 4 match rate in order to be eligible for state funds pursuant to
 5 Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$1,000,000

Section 21.060. To Lincoln University
 2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of a campus recreation
 3 center, local matching funds must be provided on a 50/50
 4 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$2,800,000

Section 21.065. To Missouri State University
 2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an admissions
 3 center, local matching funds must be provided on a 50/50
 4 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$2,500,000

Section 21.070. To Northwest Missouri State University

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an agriculture
 3 learning center, local matching funds must be provided on a 50/50
 4 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$250,000

Section 21.075. To Southeast Missouri State University

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction at Memorial Hall, local
 3 matching funds must be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate
 4 in order to be eligible for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480,
 5 RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$2,000,000

Section 21.080. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of the performing arts
 3 center at East Central College, local matching funds must be
 4 provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$50,000

Section 21.085. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of student success
 3 centers at Metropolitan Community College, local matching funds
 4 must be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be
 5 eligible for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$2,000,000

Section 21.090. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an automotive and
 3 metal technology center at State Fair Community College, local
 4 matching funds must be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate
 5 in order to be eligible for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480,
 6 RSMo
 7 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$4,175,000

Section 21.095. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of various facilities at
 3 Crowder College, local matching funds must be provided on a
 4 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible for state funds
 5 pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$750,000

Section 21.100. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of an eastern campus
 3 for Three Rivers Community College, local matching funds must
 4 be provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$5,666,046

Section 21.105. To the Coordinating Board for Higher Education

2 For planning, design, renovation, and construction of a learning commons
 3 at North Central Missouri College, local matching funds must be
 4 provided on a 50/50 state/local match rate in order to be eligible
 5 for state funds pursuant to Section 173.480, RSMo
 6 From Higher Education Capital Fund. \$1,400,000

Section 21.110. Funds are to be transferred out of the State Treasury,
 2 chargeable to the Surplus Revenue Fund, to the Higher Education
 3 Capital Fund
