## AN ACT

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to distribution of a controlled substance near child care facilities, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 195.215, to read as follows:

195.215. 1. A person commits the offense of distribution of a controlled substance
near a child care facility if such person violates section 195.211 by unlawfully distributing
or delivering any controlled substance to a person in or on, or within two hundred feet of,
the real property comprising a child care facility as defined in section 210.201, or a child
placing agency or residential care facility as defined in section 210.481.
Distribution of a controlled substance near a child care facility is a class A felony

7 which term shall be served without probation or parole if the court finds the defendant is
8 a persistent drug offender.
