	WHEREAS, the Founders of our Constitution empowered state legislators to be
2	guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the federal government; and

4	WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national debt through
5	improper and imprudent spending; and

7	WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles of the states
8	through the manipulative process of federal mandates, most of which are unfunded to a great
9	extent; and

11	WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to live under a proper interpretation of
12	the Constitution of the United States; and

14	WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of our people -
15	particularly for the generations to come - to propose amendments to the United States
16	Constitution through a convention of states under Article V to place clear restraints on these and
17	related abuses of power:

> > BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the United States Constitution until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the same subject; and

> > concurring therein, hereby apply to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the United States Constitution, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to proposing amendments to the United States Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit

> > the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for its officials
