HOUSE BILL NO. 1411

AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to tanning facilities, with a penalty provision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
- one new section, to be known as section 577.665, to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 577.665. 1. As used in this section, the following terms
- 5 shall mean:
- 6 (1) "Tanning device", any equipment that emits
- 7 electromagnetic radiation with wavelengths in the air between two
- 8 hundred and four hundred nanometers used for tanning of the skin,
- 9 including but not limited to a sunlamp, tanning booth or tanning
- 10 bed;
- 11 (2) "Tanning facility", any location, place, area,
- 12 structure, or business which provides persons access to any
- tanning device for a fee, membership dues, or any other form of
- 14 compensation.
- 15 2. Prior to any person less than seventeen years of age
- 16 using a tanning device in a tanning facility, a parent or
- quardian of such person shall annually appear in person at the

- 1 <u>tanning facility and sign a written statement acknowledging that</u>
- 2 <u>the parent or guardian has read and understands the warnings</u>
- given by the tanning facility and consents to the person's use of
- 4 <u>a tanning device at the tanning facility.</u>
- 5 <u>3. The department of health and senior services shall, by</u>
- 6 rule, develop a standard consent form to be used by all tanning
- 7 <u>facilities operating in this state. Any rule or portion of a</u>
- 8 <u>rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created</u>
- 9 <u>under the authority delegated in this section shall become</u>
- 10 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
- provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028.
- 12 This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the
- powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536
- 14 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and
- annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the
- 16 grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted
- after August 28, 2014, shall be invalid and void.
- 18 4. Any tanning facility that violates the provisions of
- this section shall be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars
- 20 for a first violation, two hundred fifty dollars for a second
- violation, and five hundred dollars for each subsequent
- violation. Every use of a tanning device in a tanning facility in
- 23 violation of this section is a separate offense.
- 24 5. The duties and penalties provided under this section
- 25 <u>shall not take effect or be enforced until the rule containing</u>
- the standard consent form has been adopted pursuant to subsection
- 27 3 of this section.
