	WHEREAS, the state of Missouri has a long history of supporting the military in their
2	mission to protect the American people; and

4	WHEREAS, Whiteman Air Force Base, home to the 442 nd Fighter Wing, is dedicated
5	to delivering dynamic air power for the United States and acting as both a powerful deterrent to
6 7	enemies and as an assurance to American citizens and allies; and
8	WHEREAS, the 442 nd Fighter Wing has a rich legacy of defending the United States and
9	its allies through its involvement in World War II, the Cold War, Operation Desert Storm,
10	Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

12	WHEREAS, the mission of the 442 nd is to maintain and support the A-10 Thunderbolt
13	II at the highest level of combat readiness; and

15	WHEREAS, the A-10 Thunderbolt II is the Air Force's only fighter plane designed for
16	close-air support providing critical front-line support for American forces on the ground and
17	conducting combat search and rescue missions; and

19	WHEREAS, the A-10 Thunderbolt II is vital to providing Missouri civilian and military
20	jobs as the 442 nd Fighter Wing is the largest tenant unit at Whiteman Air Force Base and has a
21	payroll of around \$40 million dollars, a personnel force of 1,100 people, and an economic impact
22	of millions of dollars in the local community:
