AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to requiring uniformed law enforcement officers to wear a video camera to record interactions with the public.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 590.705, to read as follows:

590.705. 1. All uniformed law enforcement officers in this state shall wear a video camera affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on duty. The video camera shall record the interaction between a law enforcement officer and a member of the public. The recording shall include both audio and video.

5 2. All law enforcement agencies shall preserve any recordings made by a video 6 camera under this section for a minimum of thirty days and shall develop any policies and 7 procedures necessary to execute the provisions of this section.

8 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to detectives or other law 9 enforcement officers while they are working in an undercover capacity, or to any law 10 enforcement officer in any situation where the wearing of such a video camera would 11 endanger the safety of the officer or the public.
