## AN ACT

To repeal section 8.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the board of public buildings.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 8.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 8.010, to read as follows:

8.010. 1. The governor, attorney general and lieutenant governor constitute the board of public buildings. The governor is chairman and the lieutenant governor, secretary. speaker of the house of representatives and the president pro tempore of the senate shall serve as ex officio members of the board but shall not have the power to vote. The board shall constitute a body corporate and politic. The board has general supervision and charge of the public property of the state at the seat of government and other duties imposed on it by law.

- 2. The commissioner of administration shall provide staff support to the board.
- 3. There is hereby created the "State Capitol Complex Subcommittee" of the board of public buildings. The state capitol complex subcommittee shall consist of the governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate, or their respective designated representatives. The subcommittee has general supervision and charge of the state capitol building, state capitol parking garages, and any other stateowned buildings adjacent to or in the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building that house any offices of the general assembly or its staff. The subcommittee shall meet at least annually and special meetings may be held at the request of at least two of the subcommittee members. Majority approval of the members of the subcommittee is 16 necessary to decide any action regarding the buildings or property under the purview of the subcommittee.
