AN ACT

To amend chapter 488, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to additional court costs for maintenance of the Kansas City municipal courthouse.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 488, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 488.2235, to read as follows:

488.2235. 1. In addition to all other court costs for municipal ordinance violations, any home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county may provide for additional court costs in an amount up to five dollars per case for each municipal ordinance violation case filed before a municipal division judge or sosciate circuit judge.

6 2. The judge may waive the assessment of the cost in those cases where the 7 defendant is found by the judge to be indigent and unable to pay the costs.

8 3. Such cost shall be collected by the clerk and disbursed to the city at least 9 monthly. The city shall use such additional costs only for the restoration, maintenance and 10 upkeep of the municipal courthouse. The costs collected may be pledged to directly or 11 indirectly secure bonds for the cost of restoration, maintenance and upkeep of the 12 courthouse.
