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### AN ACT

To repeal section 376.823, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to health insurance rebates for patients with chronic illnesses.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 376.823, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 376.823, to read as follows:

376.823. Section 191.905 shall not apply to programs established by pharmaceutical companies for the purposes of providing a partial rebate of private health insurance co-payments and coinsurance to patients with multiple sclerosis, **cancer**, or other chronic, potentially disabling, or life-threatening conditions who have been prescribed disease-managing medicines for which there are no generic equivalents.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
