AN ACT

To repeal section 9.015, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to federal holidays.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 9.015, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,
2 to be known as section 9.015, to read as follows:

9.015. No state or local governmental entity, public building, public park, public school,
2 or public setting or place shall ban or otherwise restrict the practice, mention, celebration, or
3 discussion of any federal holiday; **except that, nothing in this section shall be construed to**
4 **limit the authority to impose and enforce reasonable regulations related to the celebration**
5 **of any federal holiday in order to protect the health and safety of the public.**
