# House Resolution No. 1528

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE CURTIS.

2       **WHEREAS**, the right of workers to join together and form worker organizations is a  
3 fundamental human right recognized worldwide; and

4       **WHEREAS**, the public policy of the United States since the Wagner Act of 1935 has  
5 been to recognize and support the right of workers to bargain collectively by representatives of  
6 their own choosing; and

7  
8       **WHEREAS**, the Republican majorities in the legislatures of the states of Missouri,  
9 Wisconsin, Ohio, Indiana, New Hampshire, Idaho, and 17 other states have gone on record  
10 opposing the fundamental rights of public and private employees to bargain collectively; and

12       **WHEREAS**, the principles of democracy and the people of Missouri oppose this  
13 restriction on workers' rights;

15       **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that we, the members of the Missouri  
16 House of Representatives, Ninety-seventh General Assembly, go on record to offer support on  
17 behalf of workers' rights; and

19       **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
20 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution to the  
21 Missouri State AFL-CIO PAA.
