HB 1124 -- OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

SPONSOR: Kolkmeyer

This bill changes the laws regarding all-terrain vehicles, recreational off-highway vehicles, and utility vehicles. Currently, an all-terrain vehicle and a recreational off-highway vehicle must have a seat designed to be straddled by the operator or a seat designed to carry more than one person and specific steering controls. The bill removes these requirements. The maximum allowable width of a recreational off-highway vehicle is increased from 64 inches to 67 inches. The maximum width of a utility vehicle is increased from 63 inches to 67 inches and the maximum unladen dry weight is increased from 1,850 pounds to 2,000 pounds.
