HB 1163 -- INTRASTATE COMMERCE ACT

SPONSOR: Sommer

This bill establishes the Intrastate Commerce Act, which specifies that goods produced or manufactured in Missouri and kept within this state will not be deemed to have traveled in interstate commerce and will not be subject to federal law, regulation, or the constitutional authority of Congress to regulate commerce. These provisions will not apply to goods manufactured in this state unless the goods are clearly marked "Made in Missouri"; goods produced in this state unless the goods are clearly marked "Product of Missouri"; or goods ordered, procured, or purchased by the United States government or by any contractor under an agreement with the federal government.
