

HB 1360 -- ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES

SPONSOR: McGaugh

This bill specifies that any signature required for voter registration or petition submission under Chapter 115, RSMo, must be handwritten on a paper document. The use of a stylus or other writing utensil or a body part to mark on an electronic touchscreen must not be deemed sufficient to produce a signature for purposes of voter registration or petition signature verification. High quality copies, including electronic copies, of signatures made on paper documents may be used for petition signature verification purposes and retained as records.
