HB 1372 -- PROTEST ACTIVITIES AT FUNERAL SERVICES

SPONSOR: Cox

This bill specifies that a person commits the offense of unlawful funeral protest, a class B misdemeanor, if he or she pickets or engages in other protest activities within 300 feet of a residence, cemetery, funeral home, church, synagogue, or other establishment during or within one hour before or one hour after the conducting of any funeral or burial service at that place. These provisions do not apply to a funeral procession while it is in transit or beyond any 300-foot zone from the place where the service occurred. It is a class A misdemeanor if a person who has previously been found guilty of a violation commits the offense again.

The bill repeals Sections 578.501, 578.502, and 578.503, commonly referred to as "Spc. Edward Lee Myers' Law".
